Michael A. Fiene, Director, Internal Control Division, joined the Office of the Chief Financial Officer (OCFO) in October, 2006. The OCFO's Internal Control Division is responsible for promoting and supporting the USDA's internal control program, including the OMB Circular A-123 assessment effort, by reviewing and monitoring USDA operations and systems. The Internal Control Division is responsible for supporting effective internal control practices and promoting awareness of emerging events and trends in the area of internal control.

Prior to joining the OCFO, Mike was an Assistant Regional Inspector General and Auditor with USDA's Office of Inspector General (OIG) for 18 years. At OIG, Mike was responsible for managing, performing and/or monitoring audits of USDA consolidated and component agency financial statements, including the financial statements of the Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC), the Food and Nutrition Service (FNS), the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation (FCIC) and the Forest Service (FS). While managing and performing financial statement audits, Mike was responsible for assessing the effectiveness of agency internal controls, assessing the agency's compliance with the Federal Manager's Financial Integrity Act (FMFIA) and the Office of Management and Budget's (OMB) Circular A-123.

Mike began his Federal career as an accounting intern and then accountant with the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service (ASCS) in 1984 at ASCS' Kansas City Management Office, in Kansas City, Missouri.
